




MAIN POINT

Be overwhelmed by who God is




**Ascribe to the Lord, you heavenly beings,

Sirion like a young wild ox.


Psalm 29:5-6




The Lord sits enthroned over the flood;


Psalm 29:1-2

- **The splendor of His holiness - clothed in attire befitting His stature**


Give God His Due

The voice of the Lord twists the oaks and strips the forests bare. And in his temple all cry, “Glory!”


Psalm 29:7-9

Recognize God's Voice

- Moving storm imagery
- Starts over the sea - rumbles the sea
- Breaks the cedars
- Shakes the desert
- All of this power is attributed to the voice of God

Recognize God's Voice

- Be aware of what is going on around you
- Look for the “whoa” moments
- His voice makes the unimaginable happen

Psalm 29:10-11

Recognize God's Authority and Kingship

- God is enthroned over all
- God holds creation together
- God is ruler over judgment
- God gives strength and peace

Recognize God's Authority and Kingship

- Accept that we NEED God's strength and peace
- We need strength outside of ourselves
- We need peace that we cannot create on our own
