Why, Lord, do you stand far off? Why do you hide yourself in times of trouble? In his arrogance the wicked man hunts down the Weak, who are caught in the schemes he devises.

Psalm 10: 1-2

He boasts about the cravings of his heart; He blesses the greedy and reviles the Lord. In his pride the wicked man does not seek him; In all his thoughts there is no room for God

Psalm 10: 3-4

His ways are always prosperous; Your laws are rejected by b] him; He sneers at all his enemies. He says to himself, "Nothing will ever shake me." He swears, "No one will ever do me harm."

Psalm 10: 5-6

His mouth is full of lies and threats; Trouble and evil are under his tongue. He lies in wait near the villages; From ambush he murders the innocent. His eyes watch in secret for his victims;

Psalm 10: 7-8

Like a lion in cover he lies in wait. He lies in wait to catch the helpless; He catches the helpless and drags them off in his Net. His victims are crushed, they collapse; They fall under his strength. He says to himself, "God will never notice; he covers his face and Never sees. Psalm 10: 9-11

Arise, Lord! Lift up your hand, O God. Do not forget the helpless. Why does the wicked man revile God? Why does he say to himself, He won't call me to account"?

Psalm 10: 12-13

But you, God, see the trouble of the afflicted; You consider their grief and take it in hand. The victims commit themselves to you; You are the helper of the fatherless.
