On the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread, when it was customary to sacrifice the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples asked him, "Where do you want us to go and make preparations for you to eat the Passover?"

So he sent two of his disciples, telling them, “Go into the city, and a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him.

**Say to the owner of the house he enters,
'The Teacher asks: Where is my guest
room, where I may eat the Passover with
my disciples?'**

**He will show you a large room upstairs,
furnished and ready. Make preparations
for us there.”**

Mark 14: 15 NIV



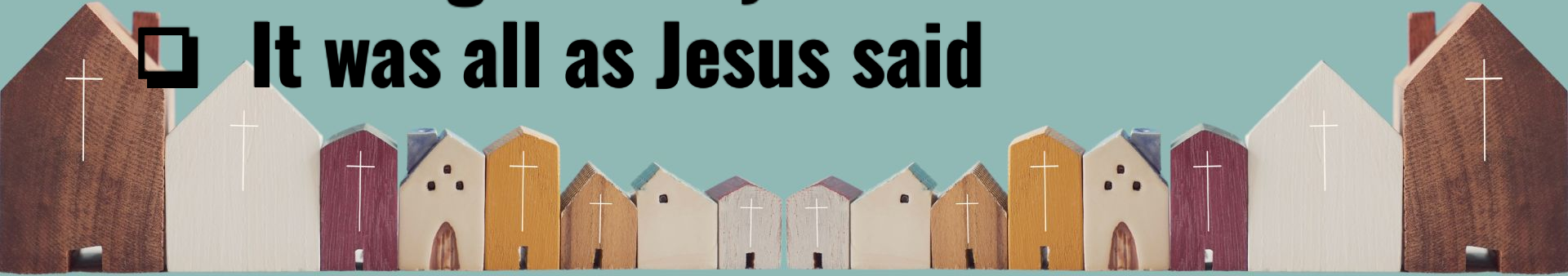
The disciples left, went into the city and found things just as Jesus had told them. So they prepared the Passover.

- ☐ Jesus gives very detailed instructions
- ☐ It was all as Jesus said





Jesus Sets The Table

- ❑ **Chair - our foundation in Christ**
- ❑ **Utensils - passions/abilities/resources**
- ❑ **Food - God feeds us**
- ❑ **Nap - God makes provides rest**

The Last Supper

- ❑ “One of you eating with me, will betray me.”
- ❑ Jesus breaks the bread and passes it out
- ❑ This is about the spreading of Jesus



The Last Supper

- ❑ **The cup and the wine**
 - ❑ **This is the sacrificial part**
 - ❑ **The blood and His death bring in the new covenant**
