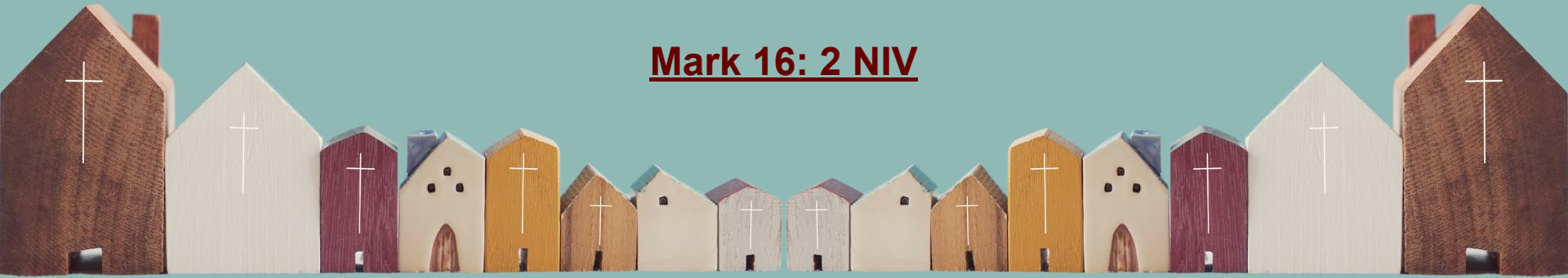
When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body

Mark 16: 1 NIV



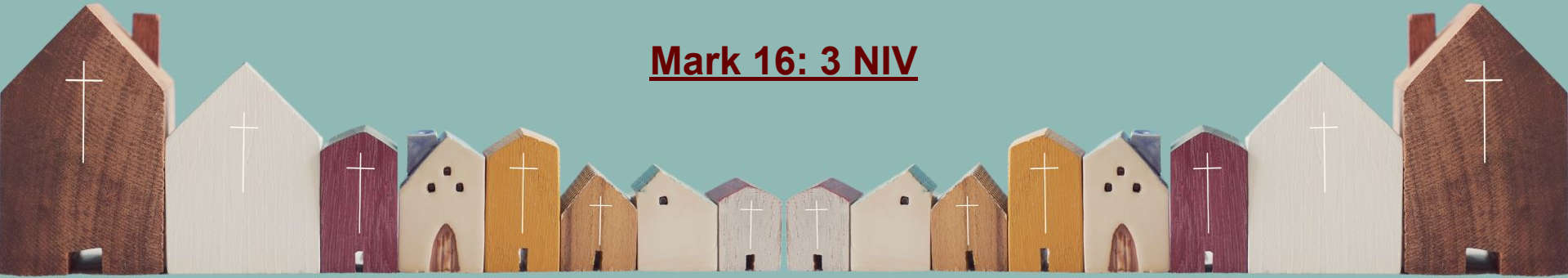
**Very early on the first day of the week,

Mark 16: 2 NIV



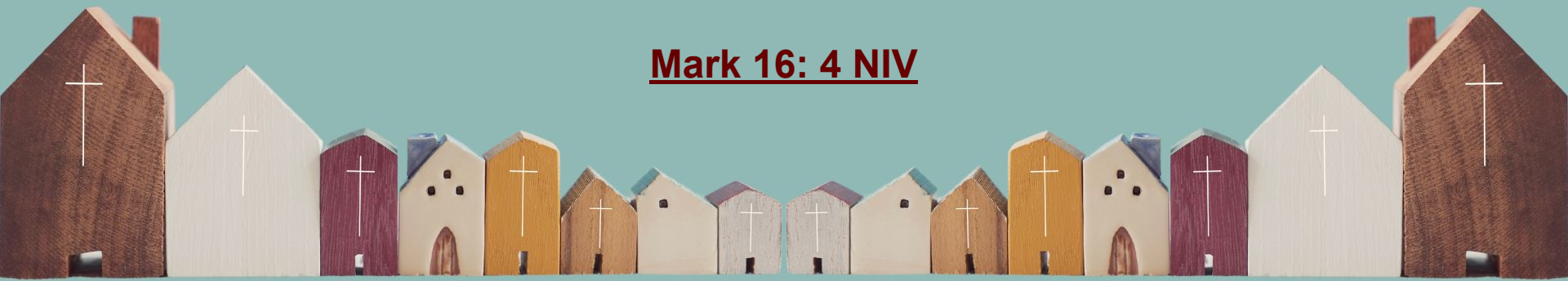
And they asked each other, “Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?”

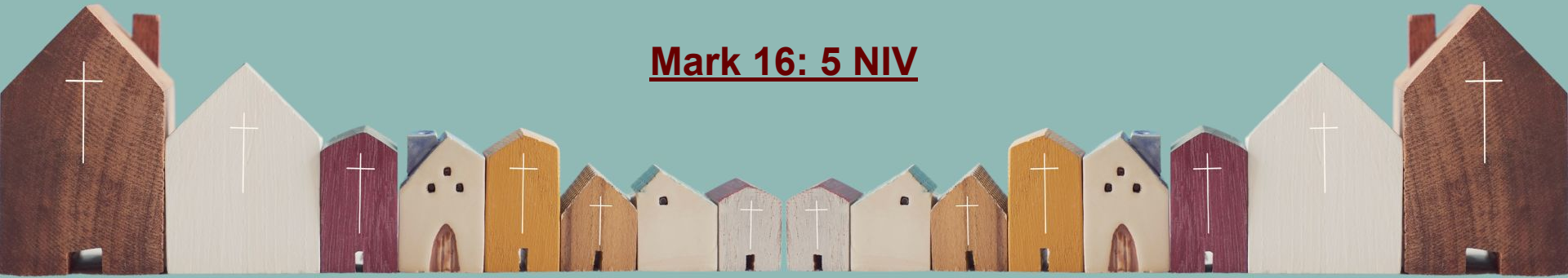
But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away.

Mark 16: 4 NIV



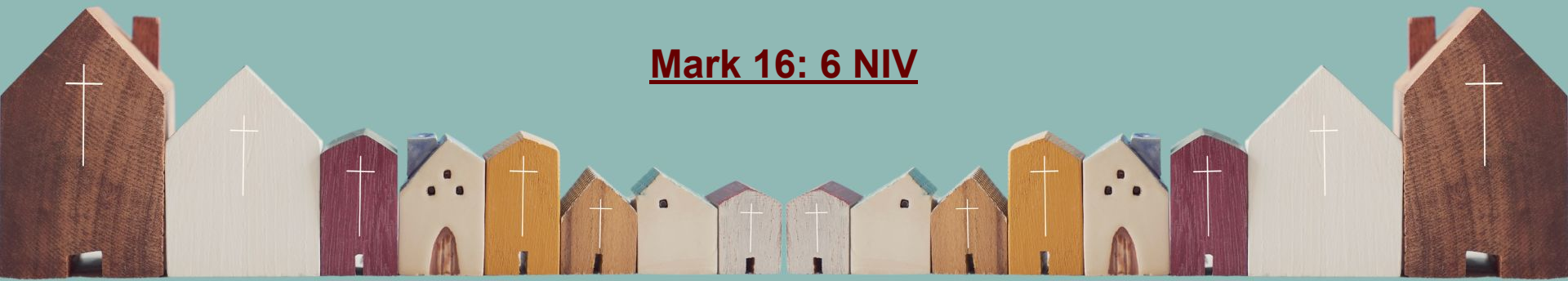
As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed.

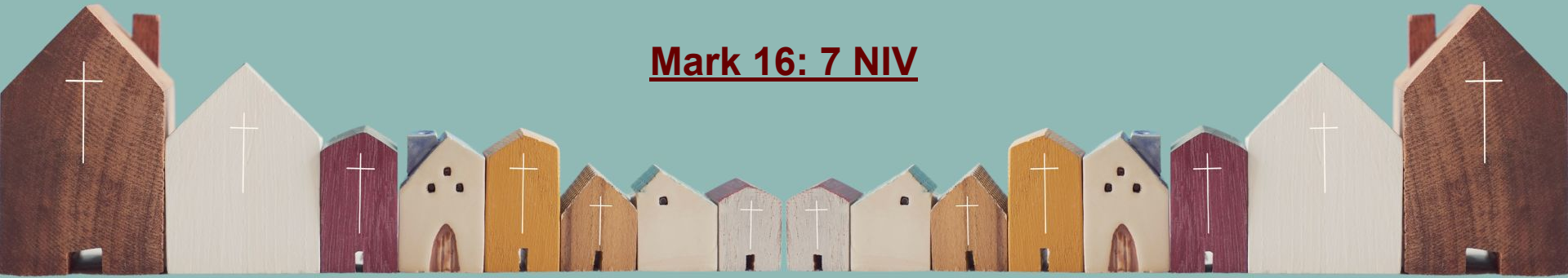
Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him.

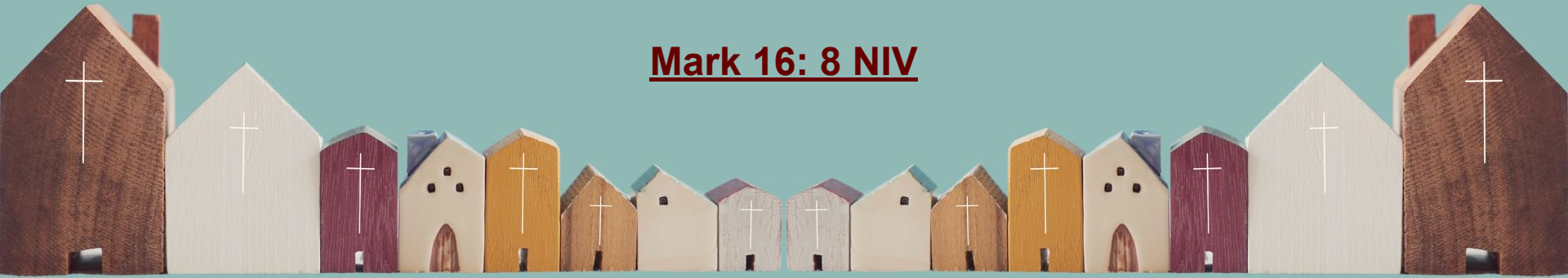
But go, tell his disciples and Peter, ‘He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.’”

The Women Go To The Tomb

- ❑ Bringing spices to anoint Jesus' body**
- ❑ Not coming with hopeful expectation that Jesus will be risen**
- ❑ They look up and the stone has been rolled away**



He Is Risen!

- ❑ The women see a young man in a white robe sitting in the tomb
- ❑ “He is not here. He has risen!”
- ❑ Go tell everyone Jesus has risen just like He said He would



What is Hope?

- ❑ **Trust, confidence, and refuge in God?**
- ❑ **Trust God**
 - ❑ **Trust is letting go**
- ❑ **Confidence in God**
 - ❑ **Belief God will come through**
- ❑ **Refuge**
 - ❑ **Safety and security in God**



Where Does Hope Lead?

- ❑ **Eternal life**
- ❑ **We are given the inheritance of eternal life that can never perish, spoil, or fade**
- ❑ **There's no stress**
- ❑ **A continued relationship with Jesus**



Don't Lose Hope

- ❑ Hope isn't ignoring the boulder in front of us that causes us to lose hope**
- ❑ Hope is recognizing that boulder is temporary**
- ❑ We get to be renewed by Jesus everyday**



Don't Lose Hope

- ❑ **Keep your eyes fixed on what is unseen not what is seen**
- ❑ **What is seen is temporary**
- ❑ **True hope in Jesus isn't temporary**



Hope Does What We Can't

- ❑ It moves the boulder
- ❑ Think about boulders in your life
 - ❑ Sin or struggle
 - ❑ Hurt or pain
 - ❑ Disappointment



Hope Does What We Can't

- ❑ God isn't a fixer
- ❑ He comes near to us, and is with us while we're dealing with all the things of life
- ❑ Hope moves the boulder when we can't
